ELIZABETH K. PORTER AWARD**

Elizabeth K. Porter served as president of the American Nurses Association (1950-1954) and of the Ohio Nurses Association (1958-1960). Throughout her career she championed the cause of staff nurses and demanded that they have the right to self-determination in matters affecting their practice and employment conditions. The American Nurses Association recognized these efforts by awarding her the Shirley Titus Award. Both ONA and ANA bestowed upon her their highest award, Honorary Recognition. The **Elizabeth K. Porter Award** recognizes the contribution that an individual nurse has made to the ONA Economic and General Welfare Program and, thereby, to the security of nurses.

Criteria:

1. The nominee has demonstrated expertise in the Economic and General Welfare Program of the Ohio Nurses Association.
2. The nominee has worked within the E&GW Program in a leadership role or has made substantial contribution(s) to advance the goals of the program.
3. The nominee is actively involved and has made contributions to and encourages involvement in ONA.
4. The nominee demonstrates professional qualities in nursing.
